I refer to your official information request we received on 2 July 2024 requesting the following:

*“Could I please request the following information under the OIA:*

- (i) What was your council spend on emergency management capability, and how many staff members did you have within emergency management roles, for the previous 3 financial years (1 July 2021 – 30 June 2022, 1 July 2022- 30 June 2023, 1 July 2023- 30 June 2024)*
- (ii) How much is your council budgeting to spend on emergency management capability, and how many staff members will you have within emergency management roles, for the current financial year (1 July 2024- 30 June 2025)”*

### **Release of information**

The information you have requested is as below.

- (i) What was your council spend on emergency management capability, and how many staff members did you have within emergency management roles, for the previous 3 financial years (1 July 2021 – 30 June 2022, 1 July 2022- 30 June 2023, 1 July 2023- 30 June 2024)

Kaikōura District Council has one Part Time Emergency Management Officer.

Spend – 1 July 2021 – 30 June 2022 = \$54,302

1 July 2022 – 30 June 2023 = \$57,232

1 July 2023 – 30 June 2024 = \$42,871

- (ii) How much is your council budgeting to spend on emergency management capability, and how many staff members will you have within emergency management roles, for the current financial year (1 July 2024- 30 June 2025)

Kaikōura District Council has one Part Time Emergency Management Officer.

Spend - Current year – 1 July 2024 – 30 June 2025 = \$105,202
