

Dog Control Report for the Year Ended 30 June 2024

1. Dog Control in the District

There were 1,262 known dogs in the district, 1,262 registered: Made up of 70 %domestic Dogs & 30% being working dogs. 3 dogs have been infringed for failure to register.

Kaikōura has one Regulatory Enforcement Officer 40 hrs. The Enforcement officer position covers all regulatory aspects alongside dog control. For the forthcoming year Dog control will be education and increasing the numbers of registered dogs.

There have been 92 complaints

7 Complaints of dogs rushing

21 Barking complaints

45 Roaming dog complaints

3. Dogs Prohibited, Leash Only and Dog Exercise Areas

Monitored, with 2024 seeing an increase in education around prohibited areas and dogs on leash to the community. We increased signage for “keep your dog under control” in all designated areas under the current bylaw. We also increased signage for “picking up dog poo”
